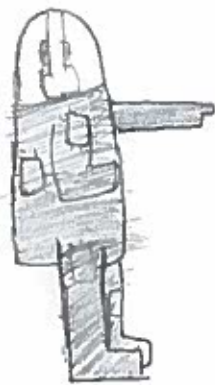
Chapter 1: The Storm

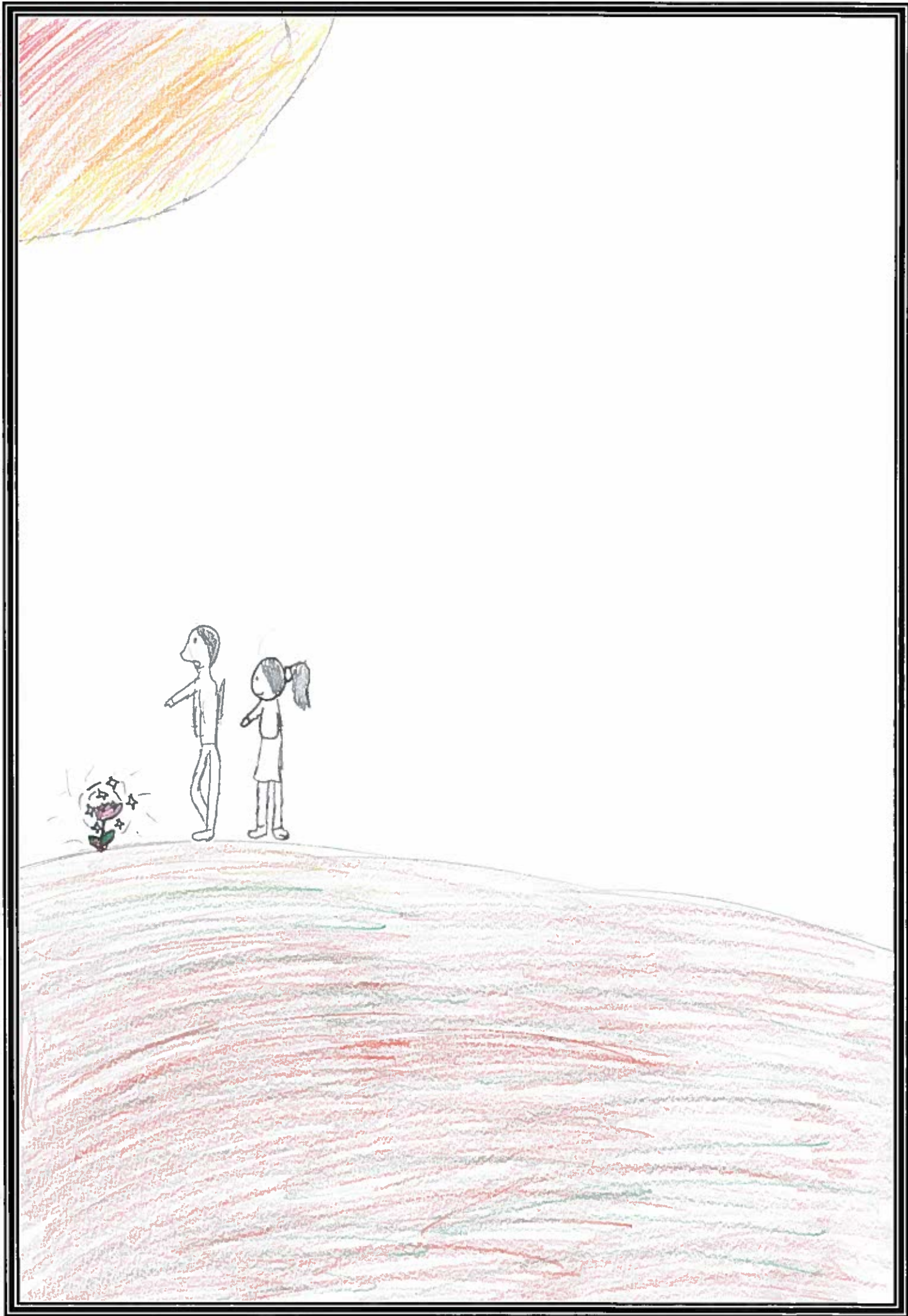


Chapter 3: The Gift And The Rescue
